


Chemistry in a coffee cup: does coffee waste contain key elements for plant growth?

- 8. Abbreviation for residues left after brewing coffee SCG
- 9. To apply a substance to soil or land to promote plant growth FERTILIZE

- 1. A colourless gas with a strong odour, composed of nitrogen and hydrogen, used in fertilizers and cleaning products AMMONIA
